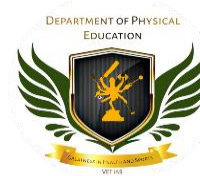

Achievements – 2022 & 2023

2022 and 2023 have been remarkable years for the students of our college, as they have achieved outstanding success in various sports events.

Jayasurya, a 2nd-year BBA student, participated in the Bharathiar University intercollegiate swimming championship in 2022 and secured a gold medal in 200M Free Style and a silver medal in 100M Back Stroke held at Bharathiar University, Coimbatore. Besides, our college women's Kho-Kho Women team won the fourth place in the Bharathiar University intercollegiate Kho-Kho tournament held at KG Arts and Science College, Coimbatore.

R. Sri Ram, a 1st-year BBA student, represented the Tamilnadu State Grappling Wrestling championship and secured a gold medal in the 54 kg category held at Mettur from 15th and 16th October 2022.

S. S. Ilakkiya Devi, a 1st-year BA Sociology student, won the Runner in the 47th State Kho–Kho Championship held at Periyakulam, Theni, from 9th Sep to 11th Sep 2022.

In addition, R. Thangaraj, a 1st-year B.COM PA student, participated in the South Zone BOXING (Youth) Championship held at Thoothukudi on 28.08.2022, and won the Bronze medal in the Bharathiar University intercollegiate Men Boxing tournament below 80kg category held at Govt. Arts College, Modakurichi.

K. Jayasurya of 2nd-year BBA represented Erode District Men Swimming team and secured a gold medal in the 100M Back Stroke, a silver medal in the 100M Free Style, and Third

Place in 200M Medley in the state-level Swimming Competition held at Virudhunagar, Tamilnadu.

S. S. Ilakkiya Devi of 1st-year BA Sociology won the Winner in the State Kho–Kho Championship which was held at Elathagiri, Krishnagiri district, on 29th Oct 2022.

G. S. Logeshwaran, a 3rd-year BBA student, won the first position in the Tamilnadu State Yoga sports championship under the 18 – 30 age categories held at tenkasi on 5th Nov 2022, and got selected for the National yoga sports championship.

Besides, S. Bala Sankar of 1st-year BBA & S. S. Ilakkiya Devi of I BA Sociology has been selected to represent the state “Tamilnadu” for the 55th Senior National Kho-Kho Championship for Men & Women 2022 from 20th Nov – 24th Nov 2022 at Osmanabad, Maharashtra.

Logeshwaran of 3rd-year B.Com-B won the Bronze Medal in the traditional yogasana sports championship, under 18 to 24 age category in the National Yogasana sports Championship, and also has won 6th place in the International yogasana sports championship held at Karnal, Haryana from 14th Nov to 16 Nov 2022.

Our student S. S. Ilakkiya Devi of 1st-year BA-Sociology won the Winner in the State Kho–Kho Championship and got the Best player Award, which was held at Salem on 27th Nov 2022.

R. Sri Ram, a 1st BBA student, represented our college at the National Grappling (Wrestling) Championship in Gonda, U.P. from 24th Nov to 27th Nov 2022 and showcased his skills. Additionally, R. Sri Ram participated in the Tamilnadu State Level Wrestling championship 2023 and secured a Silver Medal in the 54 kg category held at Karur.

Ms. T. Mathimalar, a III B Com (CA) student, who won the Gold Medal in the double stick event in the VSDF federation cup 2022 held at Erode, and also secured another Gold Medal in the Chief Ministers Trophy and received a cash reward of rupees 3000/- held in Erode district.

Moreover, our college had two students M. Harshan Prasath and M. Balaji Prasath, both from III B COM-B, who won silver and gold medals respectively in the Senior Boys Taekwondo Championship on 11th December 2022 held at Erode district.

R. Thangaraj, a 1st B. Com (PA) student, has also made us proud by winning the silver medal in the first state-level invitation Boxing (Men) tournament in the 70kg category held at Karur on 24.12.2022.

We also have exceptional athletes in our college. M. Meha, a 3rd BA sociology student, won the Bronze medal in the Bharathiar University intercollegiate Athletic Meet in the Hammer throw event on 27.12.2022 at Bharathiar university, Coimbatore.

event at all India Inter University Athletic Championship held at Tamilnadu Physical Education and Sports University, Chennai on 13th March of 2023.

Furthermore, our college's Kho-Kho player, S.S.Ilakiyadevi, a 1st-year Sociology student, secured second place in the 4th Vellakovil Marathon and received a cash prize of Rs.7000/- in the competition held on 12th Feb 2023 at Vellakovil.

Additionally, K. Jayasurya, a 2nd BBA student, participated in the Chief Ministers Trophy in five events and won the 5 Gold medals and received the cash reward of rupees 15000/- held at Erode.
